Cultural Geography Project



Introduction

a. You will become cultural geographers and study the history and culture of a particular country or region. Once you have sufficiently researched your topic, you will present the information as a video presentation, as a PowerPoint or google docs presentation. The information below provides you with the requirements for your presentation.

Information to include in your presentation.

- **a.** Brief <u>history</u> of the country or region. Also include GDP total and per capita income, NIR, total population, literacy rate and HDI (Human Development Index)
- **b.** <u>Music:</u> genres, artists, importance in celebration and instruments unique to the region (play some music)
- **c.** Food: discuss the influence of cultural diffusion on the food; prepare a dish
- **d.** <u>Language:</u> what is the official language, how many people speak it, teach us some words, where did it originate (include the language branch, family and group)
- **e.** <u>Ethnicity:</u> Explain the different ethnicities, nationalities, centripetal forces and centrifugal forces
- **f.** Religion: are the religions universalizing or ethnic, what are the basic beliefs, branches and sects
- g. Environment: how has the environment influenced culture?
- **h.** <u>Popular vs. Folk culture:</u> What aspects of popular and folk culture exist (include habits and customs)
- i. Popular tourist destinations (Include 3 to 5)

Requirements

- a. PowerPoint Presentation
 - You must include a minimum of 20 slides (Each slide must include a picture) Use at least 18 pt. font for the text
 - ii. You must include in-text-citations for all information and pictures.

 Projects will not be accepted without in-text citations and you must have a work cited page in proper MLA format.
- **b.** Bibliography in MLA format including at least ten sources as the last page of the power point.
- **c.** Food from your country or region.

- **d.** Music or Movie clips (Optional) Youtube will be acceptable, though I must preview the clip before your presentation
 - i. You can include a 5-10 minute song or movie clip.
- **e.** You must submit a paper copy of the Power point (6 slides per page) one day before you present.
